


Welcome to MOD.

They wear black or purple vests with strips. They are friendly and you can ask them for help if you need.




There are eight galleries that you can explore.

There are some lights, projectors and sculptures that will hang from the ceiling.


These are secured safely and won't fall down.

You can take the stairs or the lift to get between the Ground and First Levels.









If you want to go outside, we have a balcony on the first level.

The Terrace overlooks the train tracks. It can be fun to watch the trains, but it can also be noisy!






If you need a break there is a multiaccess suite available on level 1 near Futures Gallery.


Inside there are private rooms with chairs.
