On the Level 1, turn right from the stairs, the lift lobby, or Arcade Gallery to view Star Dreaming in Motion from the Level 1 balcony.

Star Dreaming in Motion

Signage reads: Where do we belong in the expansiveness of the universe?

The universe is vast and seems to stretch forever. It can make us feel very small, but it's important to know we belong. This artwork positions us above the skies, amongst the stars and space, looking through to Country. As you observe this changing sculpture, your perspective of the Universe and our place within it may also shift.

Access seating:

Star Dreaming in Motion can be viewed from below, by sitting or standing in the café and foyer area on the Ground Floor, or from the balcony on Level 1 or 2.

Audio description:

A cluster of 30 circular panels, each roughly 1 metre in diameter, are suspended high from the foyer ceiling. They catch the foyer's natural light as well as being lit from above by white strip lighting, allowing multiple colours to reflect, refract and shimmer across and between their semi-opaque surfaces. The overlapping circles shine with patches of blue, teal, pale orange, purple and silver light, oriented at different heights and angles. Each circle is printed with groups of small dark dots and rings, like pores, or craters on the surface of a planet. The panels occasionally move very slowly and subtly.
